The **University at Buffalo (UB) Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (LSAMP)** offers several **PAID** research experiences for undergraduates and MS students at our suburban Buffalo campus. We invite diverse students from undergraduate engineering and applied science programs to participate in our summer research programs:

LSAMP Program Highlights

- A \$5,250 stipend
- Hands-on research/training in synthetic biology of plant natural products
- Seminars, workshops, and other professional development activities
- Networking opportunities with UB faculty
- Opportunities to publish/present research at conferences

Eligibility

- Full-time undergraduates/MS students majoring in an engineering discipline with an interest in research
- Completed a minimum of 30 credits (undergraduates) or one semester of graduate work (MS students) before the start of the program
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Cumulative GPA of 2.80 or better (MS students 3.00 or better)
- LSAMP supports broadening participation from groups that have been historically underrepresented in STEM disciplines
- Graduating seniors are ineligible

LSAMP Application deadline: **March 18, 2024.**
